<b>Description:</b>	Hand And Brain is a very exciting and funny chess variant where each colour is played by two people. One of them (the “brain”) announces one of the six pieces (king, queen, rook, bishop, knight, or pawn), and the other player (the “hand”) moves the named piece on the board. The catch: the “brain” cannot tell the specific move they want to play (e.g. which bishop to move or where to), or give any hint to help the “hand” to figure it out.
